FINANCIAL REPORT THOMAS C HART VETERANS ASSOCIATION SEPTEMBER 2017 RANDY GROEN

It was great seeing everyone at the reunion. Already looking forward to the next one in Rapid City.

The TC Hart treasury currently has a total of \$1102.12. Included in that total is \$324 that is dedicated to the "Help a Shipmate Fund", and \$57.36 is in our PayPal account.

The total cost for Reunion in Minneapolis was \$9074. This includes all the venues, tours, food and \$153 of PayPal fees for reunion registering on line. We collected \$7345 from the registration fees leaving \$1639 that was paid out of the Treasury.

Our only source of income is your membership fees. If you are not a member, please join.

World's Best Cookies

My mother baked cookies for me to bring to the reunion, and several of the attendees asked for the recipe. Sorry it took so long, but here it is. (PS I did not make up the name for the cookies. That was how it was titled in my Mom's cook book)

1 cup sugar 1 cup brown sugar 1 cup butter 1 cup vegetable oil

1 egg 1tsp vanilla
1 tsp salt 1 tsp baking soda

1tsp cream of tartar1cup rice krispies1 cup coconut1 cup instant oat meal

1 cup mixed chopped nuts 3 ½ cups flour

Cream the butter and sugars till fluffed. Add egg and oil and mix well. Add oatmeal and nuts and mix well. Add remaining ingredients and mix well. Drop from a tea spoon onto an ungreased cookie sheet and flatten with a fork that has been dipped in ice water. Bake in pre-heated oven at 325 for 12 to 14 minutes.
